

Slight to Moderate elsewhere.







02 Feb/One Dead After Containers Fall Overboard/Indonesian

2026.02.02	Indonesian	Tanjung Perak Port	Crew Over Board	Name - Pacific 88 Flag - Antigua And Barbuda Type - Cargo	One port worker fell into the water and was reported missing, prompting a search and rescue operation and temporary suspension of port operations.

On 02 Feb 26, the cargo vessel Pacific 88 at Tanjung Perak Port in Subaraya, Indonesia, developed a severe list during loading and unloading, leading to around 30 containers falling into the sea. The incident occurred around 0400 hrs WIB and was attributed to improper cargo handling.



04 Feb/General Cargo Vessel Runs Aground/Sweden

2026.02.04	Sweden	Port of Varberg	Grounding	Name - CL Flanders Flag - Belgium Type - Cargo	The Swedish Coast Guard has initiated a preliminary investigation into an incident, concentrating on potential negligence in maritime traffic.

The Belgium-flagged general cargo vessel CL Flanders ran aground carrying timber in the port of Varberg, Sweden, on the night of 4 February. All eight crew members were reported safe with no injuries. The vessel is positioned against the pier at Getteron's marina, and salvage operations are anticipated to commence the following day.



02 Feb/Tanker "Intergod VII" Refloated After Running Aground/Colombia

2026.02.04	Colombia	Off Santa Marta	Grounding	Name - Intergod VII Flag - Colombia Type - Tanker	On 04 February, authorities confirmed that the vessel was successfully refloated after weather improvement and towed to the nearby Santa Marta port terminal.

Colombia's General Maritime Directorate (DIMAR) reported that the Colombian-flagged bunker tanker Intergod VII grounded off Santa Marta on 2 February. The crew and vessel were unharmed, with no pollution reported. The incident occurred at around 2230 Hrs local time in Playa Los Cocos. Following the distress report, emergency response protocols were activated by the Colombian Navy's Coast Guard Station, with assistance from local tugboats.
