

Weather:

OCNL Showers / T'Showers in sections : 30, 45, 50, 55, 65, 70, 75, 80

SCT Showers / T'Showers in sections : 10, 20, 35, 40, 60, 85

ISOL Showers / T'Showers elsewhere.

Winds:

North of Shear line

West of 75E: NW'y, N'y or Variable / (10-20)kts

East of 75E: NE'y or N'y/ (10-20)kts; gusting up to (25) kts in sections 05, 10, 30

In-between Shear line and ITCZ

West of 70E: SW'y / (10-20)kts

East of 70E: SW'y to W'y/ (10-20)kts; gusting up to (25-30) kts in sections 45, 50, 55, 70

South of ITCZ:

SE'y / (10-20)kts; gusting up to (25) kts in sections 80

Seas:

Rough in section : 50, 70

Fairly rough, rough at times in section : 45, 55

Moderate, fairly rough at times in sections : 05, 10, 25, 30, 65, 75, 80

Moderate in sections : 15, 35, 85

Slight to Moderate elsewhere.





## Tropical Cyclone Gezani



## 07 Feb/Bulk Carrier Runs Aground/Finland

2026.02.07	Finland	North of Seskar Island	Grounding	Name : SFERA Type : Cargo IMO : 9304576 Flag : Marshall Islands	The vessel incurred no damage or water ingress and the crew is working to refloat it. The Leningrad-Finnish Transport Prosecutor's Office is investigating the incident.

The incident involved a vessel transporting 72,000 tonnes of mineral fertilizers from Ust-Luga, Russia, to Skagen, Denmark. All 22 crew members were reported safe, with no oil pollution confirmed after the grounding.



2026.02.07	Finland	Gulf Of Finland	Collision	Name : GLYFADA    Name : Aeolian fortune Type : Cargo      Type : Cargo Flag : Malta        Flag : Portugal	The Northwestern Transport Prosecutor's Office is investigating the cause of a collision, with details on the damage to the vessels still undisclosed.

The bulk carriers 'MV GLYFADA' and 'MV AEOLIAN FORTUNE' collided in the Gulf of Finland without disrupting traffic for other vessels. The Malta-flagged 'MV GLYFADA' remained at the scene for damage assessment, while the Portugal-flagged Aeolian Fortune continued its voyage to the Russian port of Ust-Luga.

## 06 Feb/53 Migrants Dead After Boat Capsizes/Libya

2026.02.06	Libya	Coast of Libya	Capsized	Migrate Boat	The vessel carrying 55 migrants, including two babies, capsized six hours after departing from Al-Zawiya, Libya.

At least 53 migrants, including infants, died or went missing after an overcrowded boat capsized off Libya, with only two women rescued. This incident underscores the dangers of the Central Mediterranean migration route during extreme weather.
