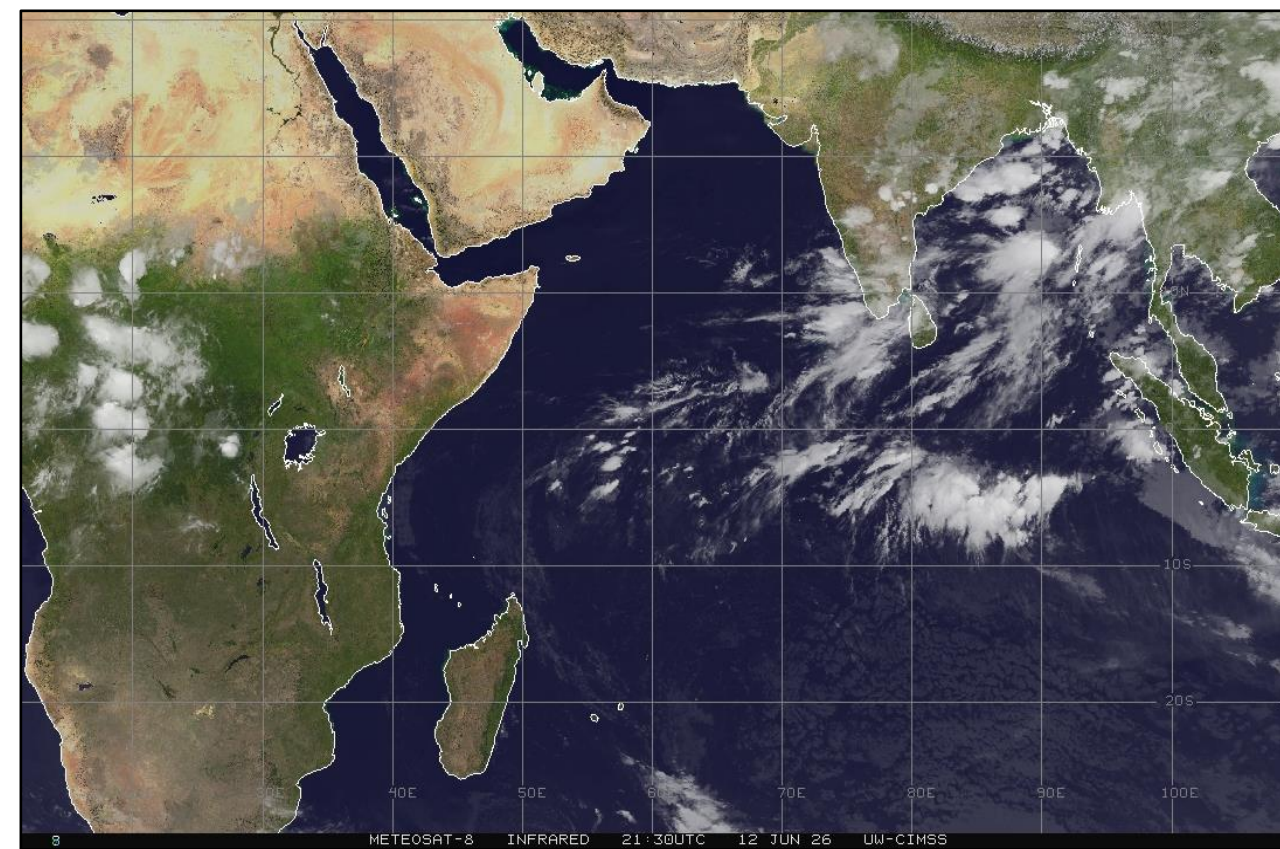

Rough to very rough in Section : 05, 10

Fairly rough, rough at times in Sections : 65, 70, 80, 85

Moderate, fairly rough at times in Sections : 00, 15, 25, 30, 60, 75

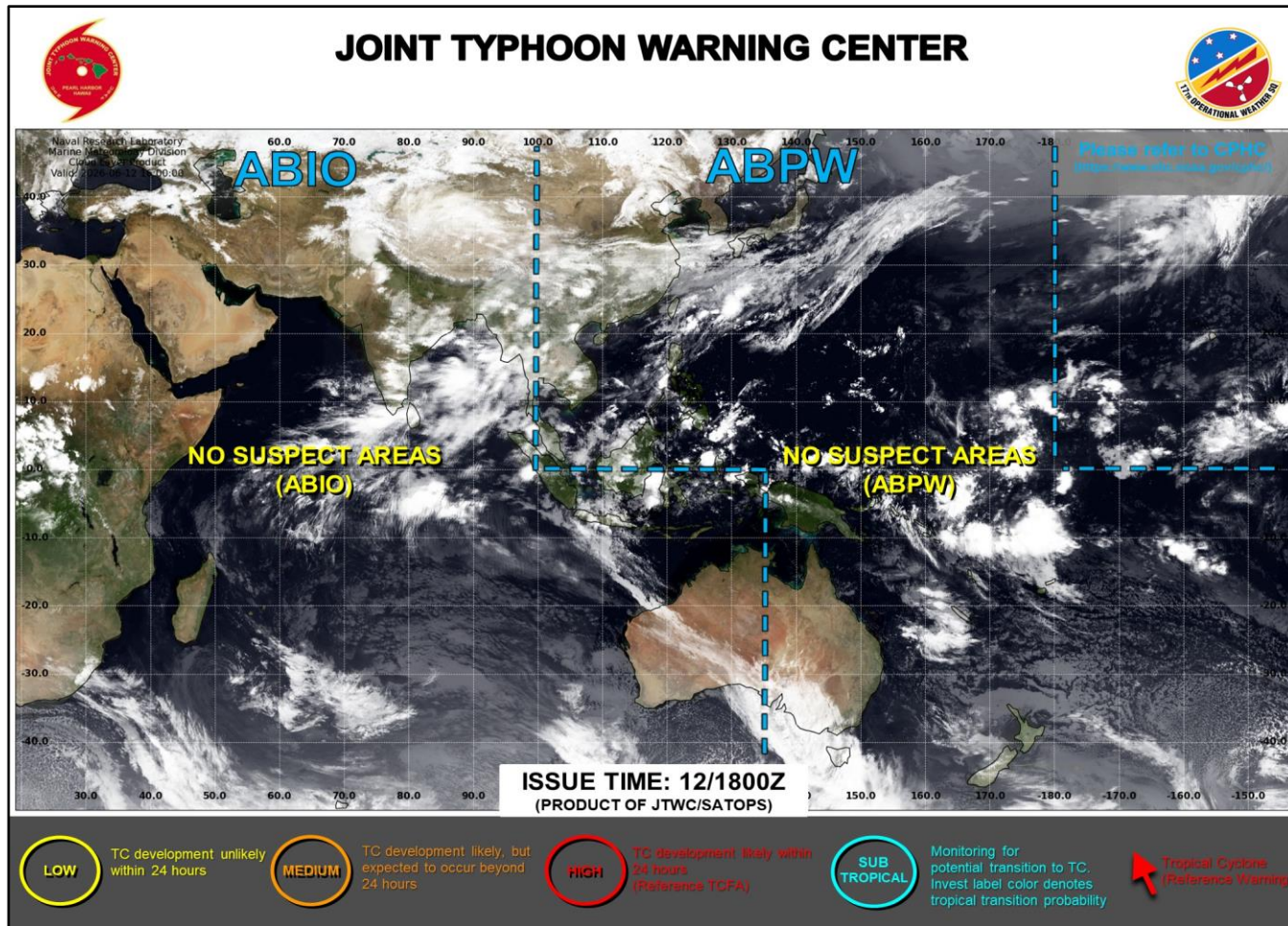
Moderate in Sections : 20, 45, 50, 55

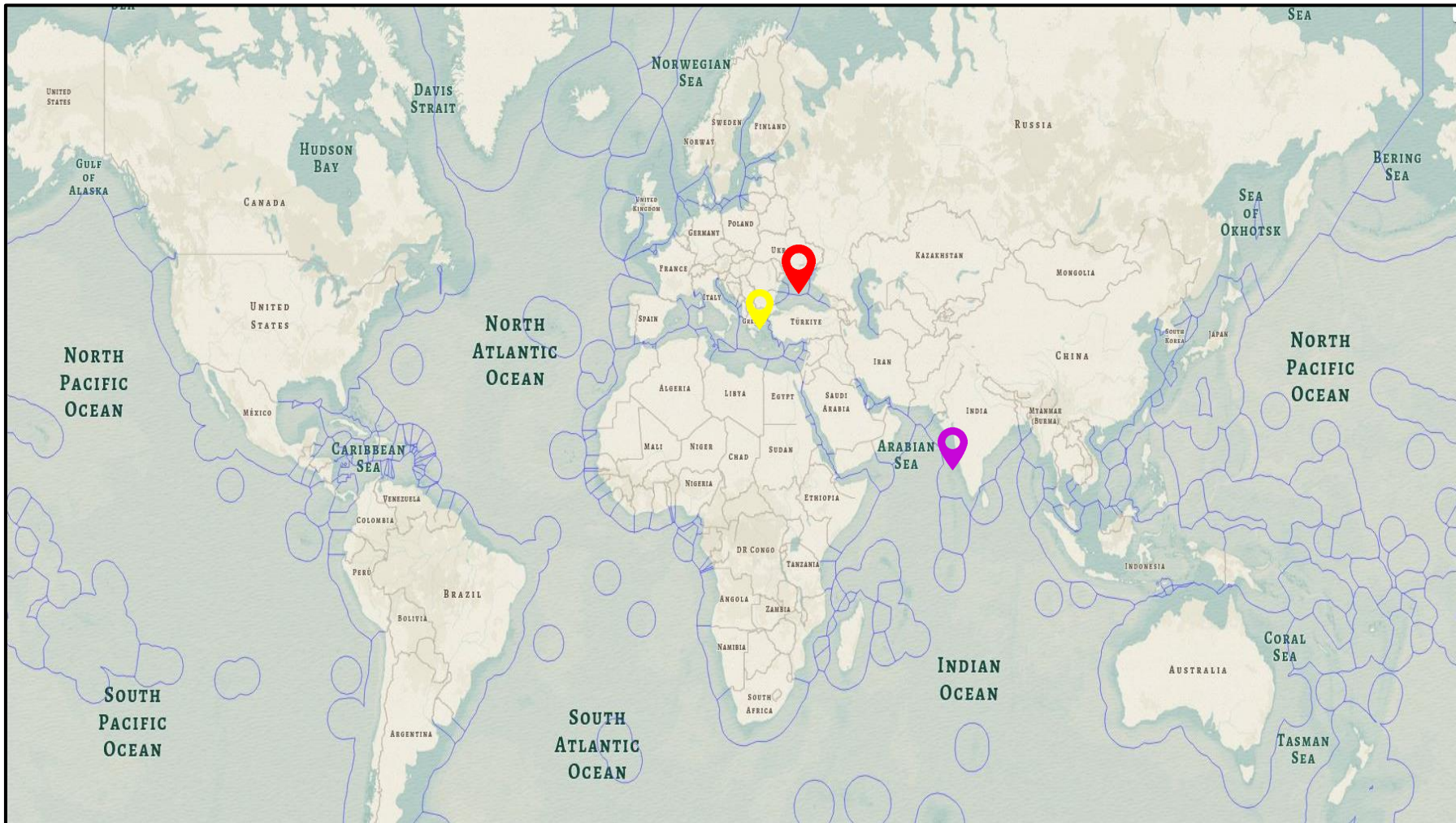

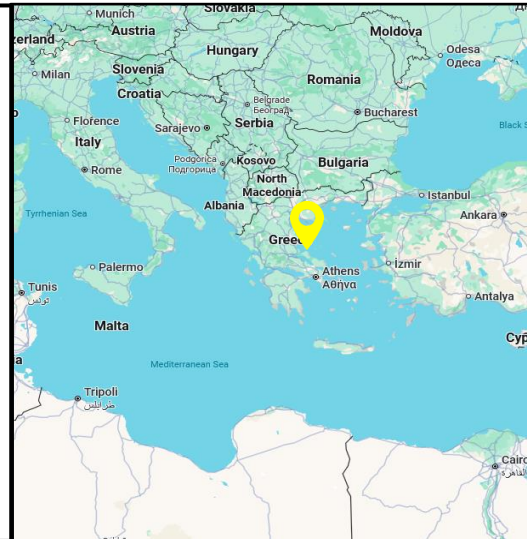

08 Jun/Passenger Ferry Involved in Collision/Greece

2026.06.08	Greece	Port of Rafina	Collisions	Passenger Vessel	No injuries were reported among passengers or crew, and there was no pollution. Coast Guard and port officials quickly assessed the damage to the vessel and port infrastructure.

The Greek-flagged Ro-Ro passenger ferry Andros King collided with a jetty at the Port of Rafina, Greece, on 8 Jun 26, causing severe damage to the jetty. The vessel itself was unharmed and was cleared for its next sailing the next day. At the time of the incident, the Andros King was arriving from Mykonos and carried 283 passengers, 60 crew members, and various vehicles.

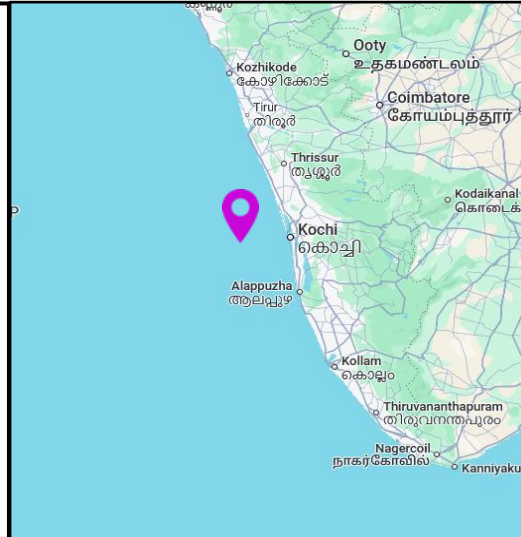

11 Jun/Navy Clears Warhead from Missile-Hit Crude Tanker/India

2026.06.11	India	Off Kochi	Naval Activities	Name – Olympic Flag - Marshall Islands Type - Tanker	The vessel, without Indian nationals, reported unexploded ordnance while en route to Kochi.

The Indian Navy has successfully retrieved an unexploded missile warhead from the MT Olympic Life, a Marshall Islands-flagged crude oil tanker. The tanker, en route from Fujairah, UAE, to Kochi, reported an explosion in its hull near the coast of Oman on 26 May 26, prompting a complex explosive ordnance disposal operation.

11 Jun/Two Foreign Cargo Ships Damaged in Russian Drone Attack/ Ukraine

2026.06.11	Ukraine	Black Sea	Assault violations	Two Cargo Vessels	Russia launched drone attacks on southern Odesa, targeting civilian infrastructure and energy facilities. Emergency services are responding, but no casualties have been reported.

Two foreign cargo ships, flagged from Barbados and Panama, were damaged in a Russian drone attack while navigating through Ukraine's maritime corridor in the Black Sea, as reported by Ukrainian officials, including Oleh Kiper, head of the Odesa Regional Military Administration.
