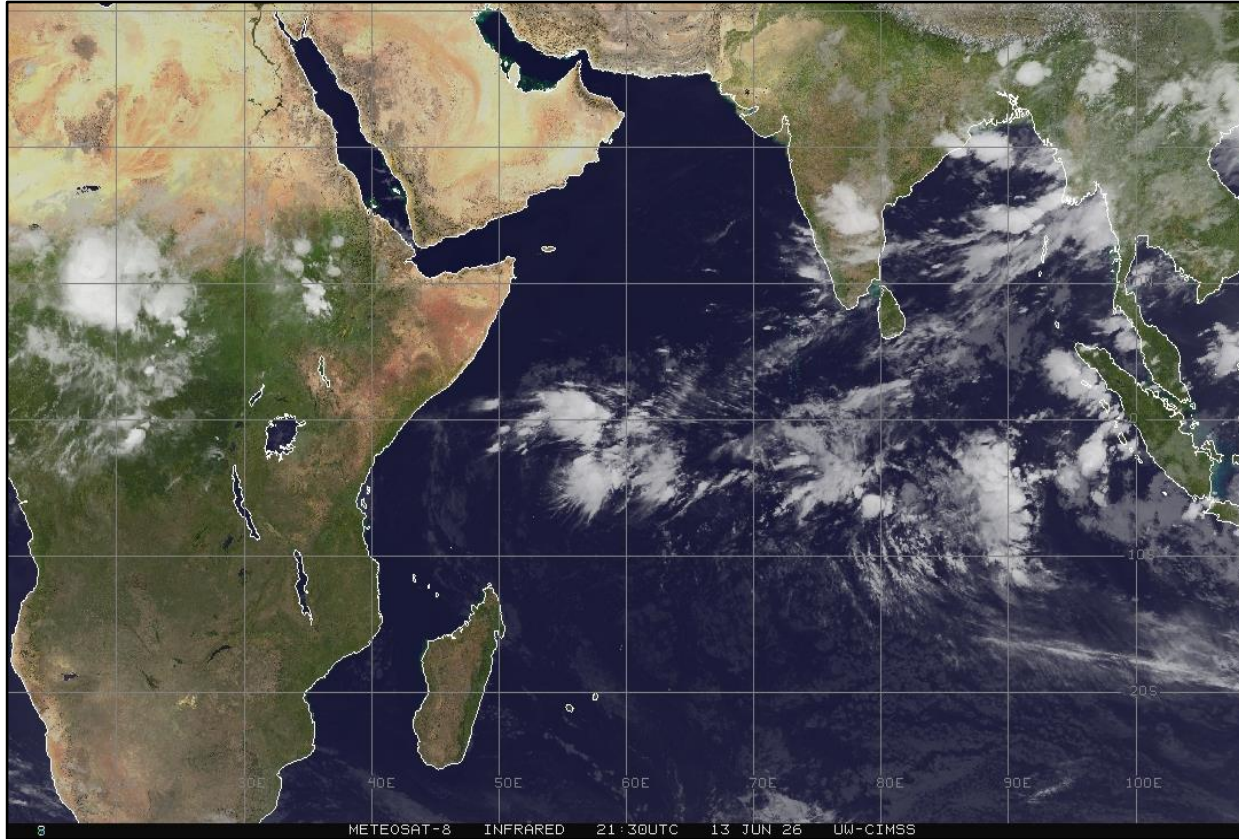

Moderate, fairly rough at times in Sections : 00, 15, 60, 75

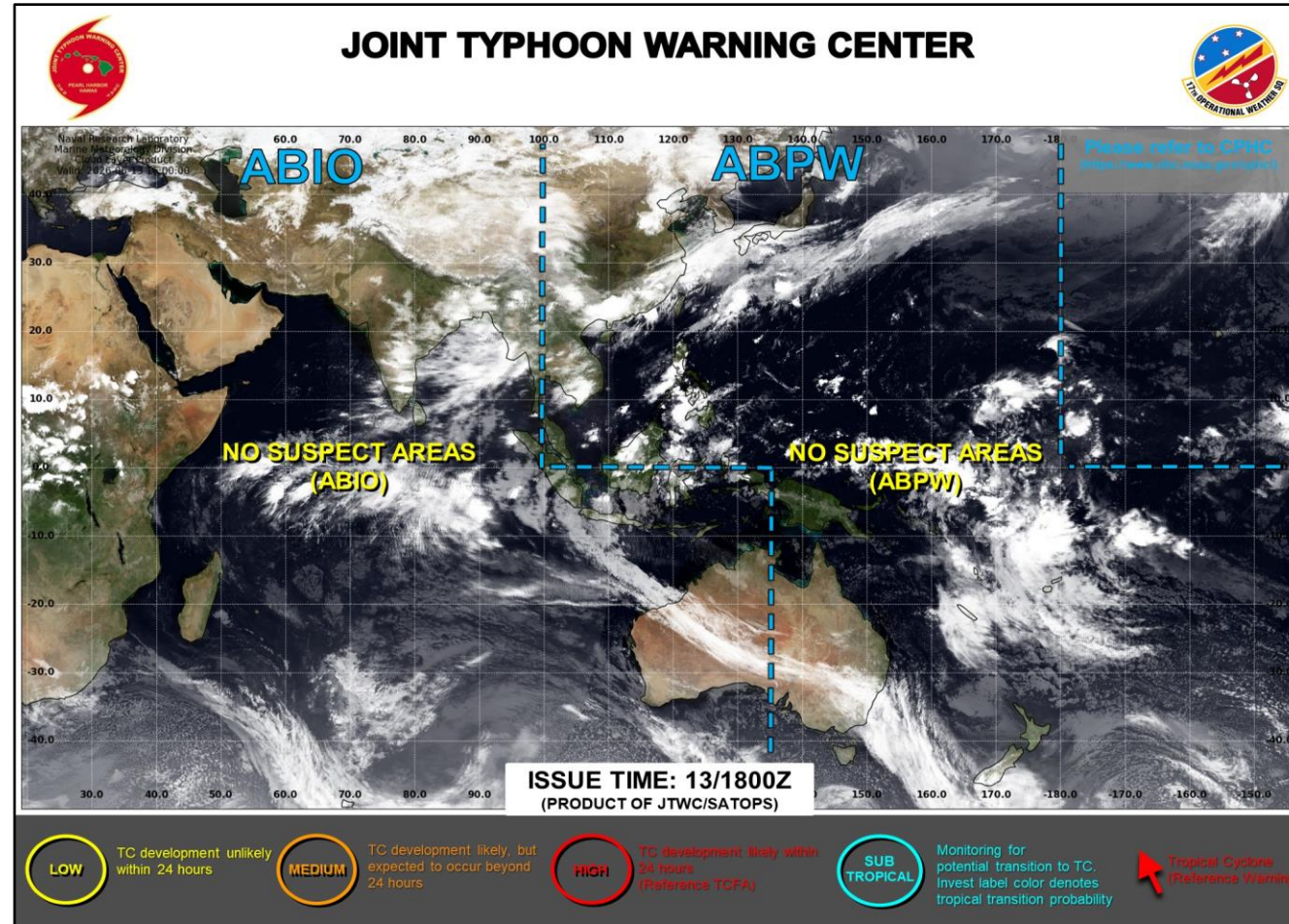
Moderate in Sections : 20, 55

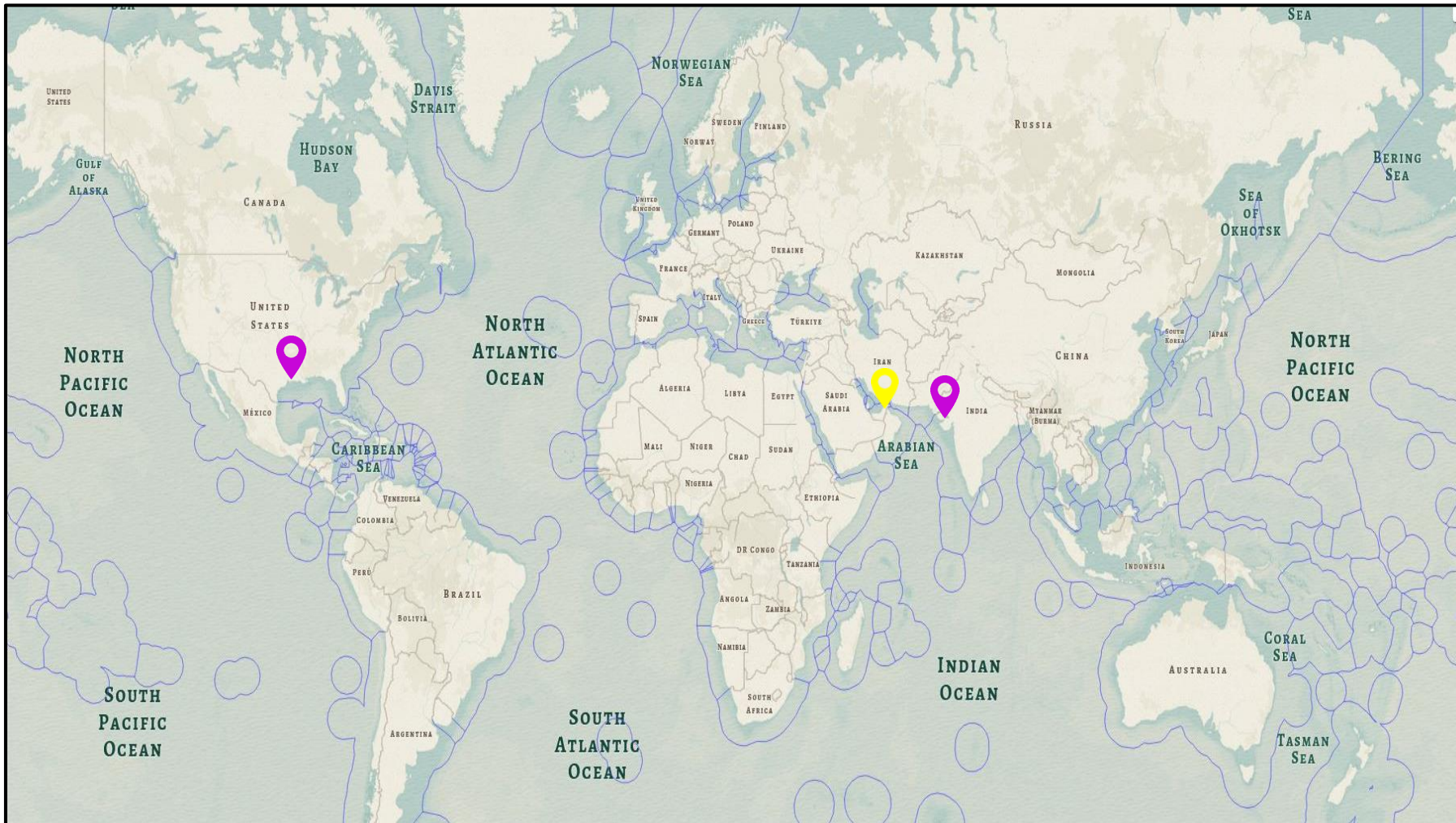

13 Jun/ Tanker Attacked In Hormuz Even As Peace Deal Looms/ Hong Kong

2026.06.13	Oman	Strait of Hormuz	Assault violations	Tanker Vessel	The attack coincides with reports of a potential peace deal between the US and Iran, expected to be signed within 24 hours, which would involve Iran re-opening the Strait of Hormuz and the US lifting its blockade of Iranian ports.

A Hong Kong-Flagged tanker was hit by an unknown projectile on its port bow while navigating the Strait of Hormuz, six nautical miles east of Oman, at 0230 hrs local time on 13 Jun 26. The impact damaged the ballast tank and caused cargo leakage, but no environmental pollution was reported, and the crew remained safe. The vessel continued to its destination, anchoring at Fujairah for damage assessment. Authorities are investigating the incident.



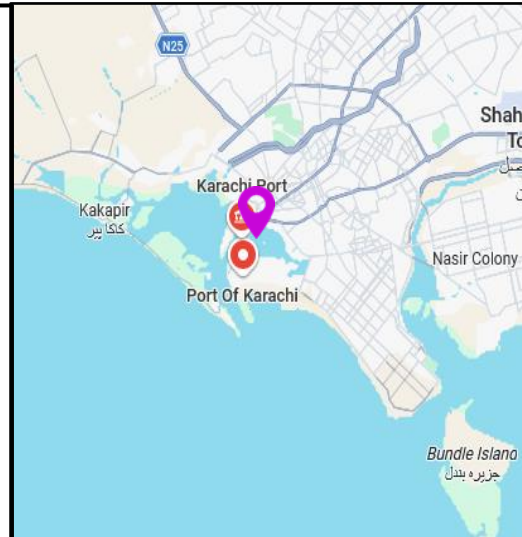

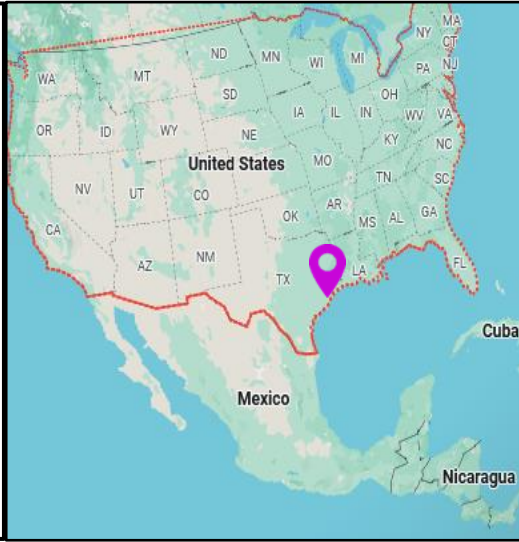

13 Jun/180-Foot Drone Ship To Conduct First-Ever Hypersonic Missile Launch From Unmanned Surface Vessel/ USA

2026.06.13	USA	-	Foreign affairs	-	Deploying hypersonic weapons from unmanned vessels may enhance the number of launch platforms and decrease dependence on crewed ships.

Two U.S. defence technology companies, Saronic and Castelion, are collaborating to launch a hypersonic missile from an unmanned surface vessel. Castelion's Blackbeard hypersonic system will be integrated with Saronic's Marauder medium unmanned surface vessel (MUSV), with plans for an at-sea demonstration in 2027. The project aims to enhance autonomous maritime technology alongside hypersonic strike capabilities for future naval operations.
