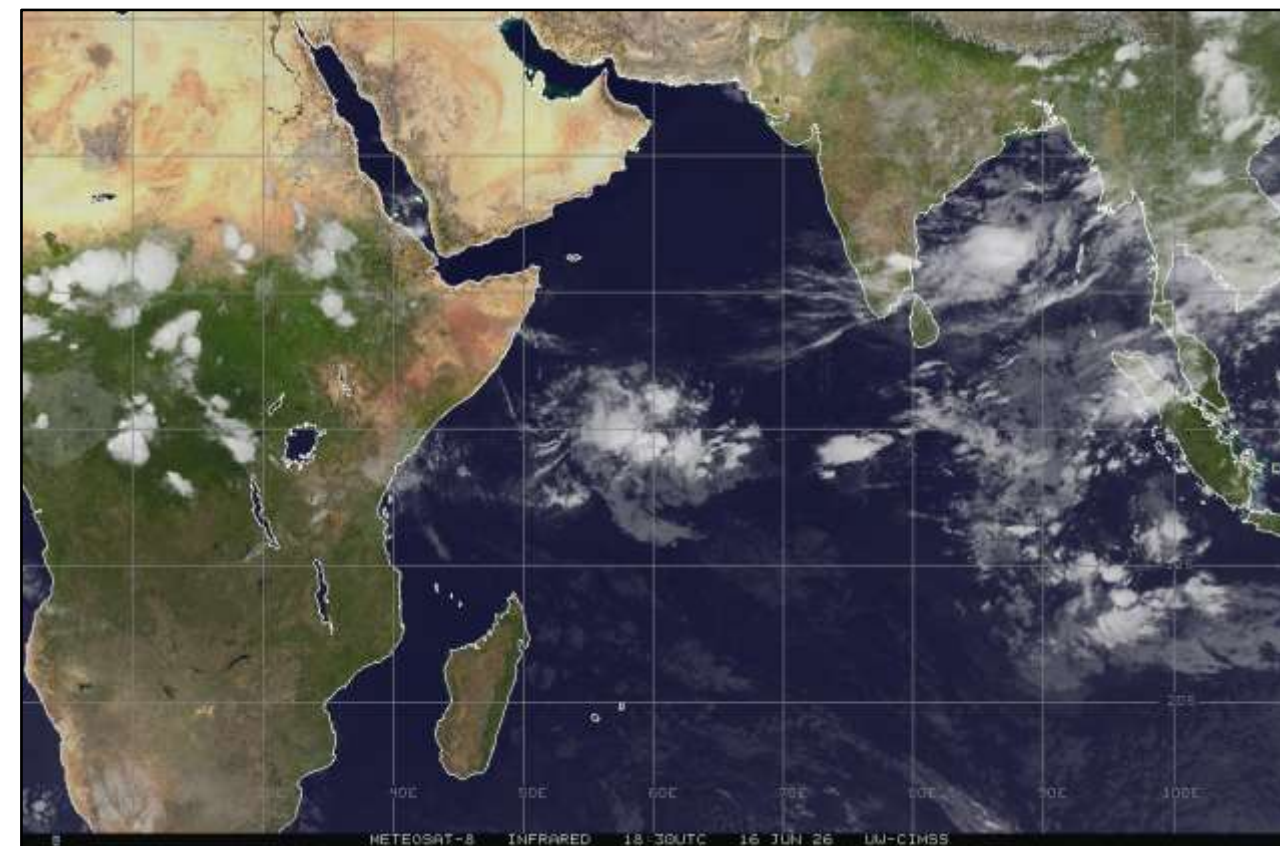

Moderate, fairly rough at times in Sections : 00, 20, 25

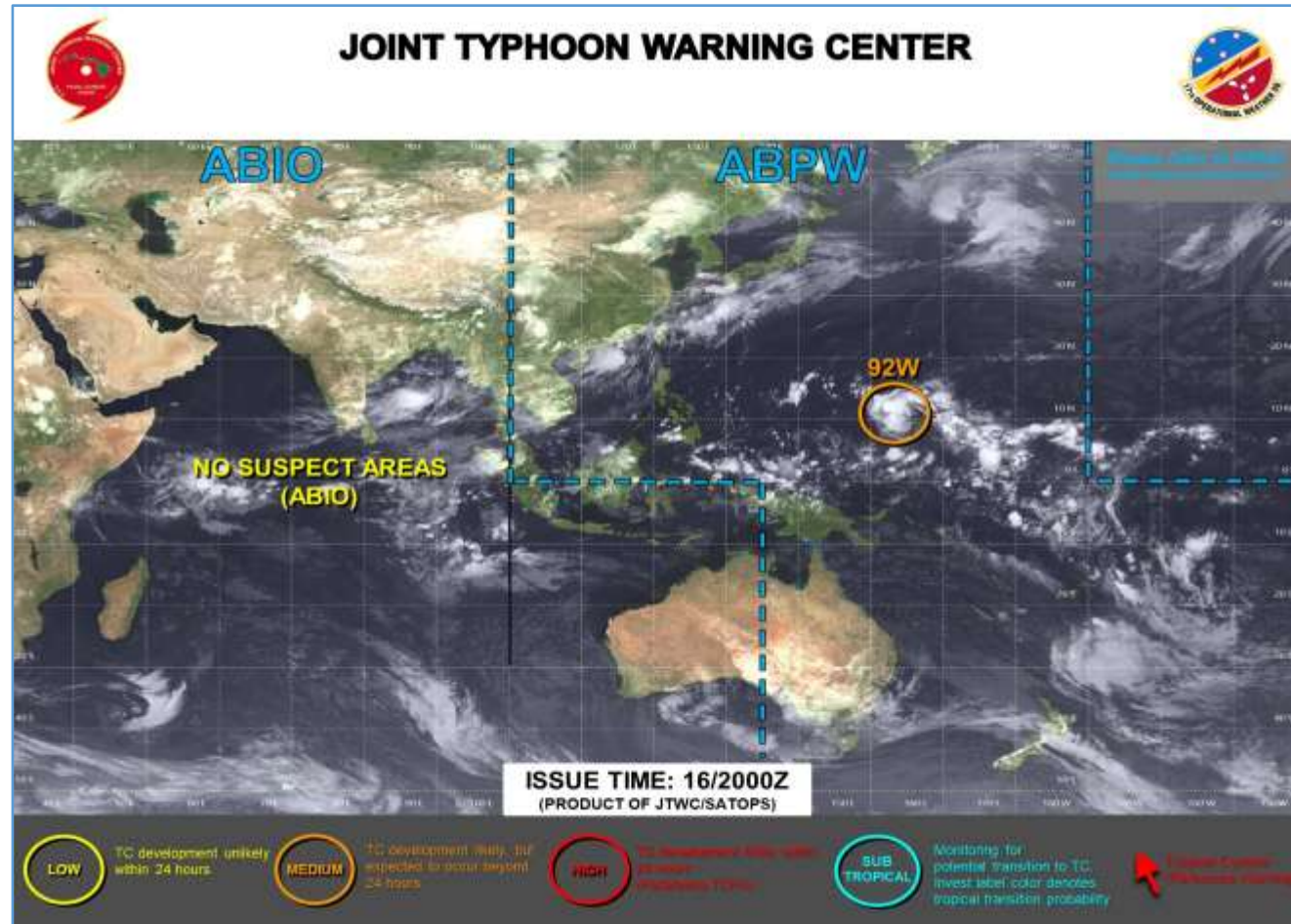
Moderate in Sections : 40, 60, 75, 80

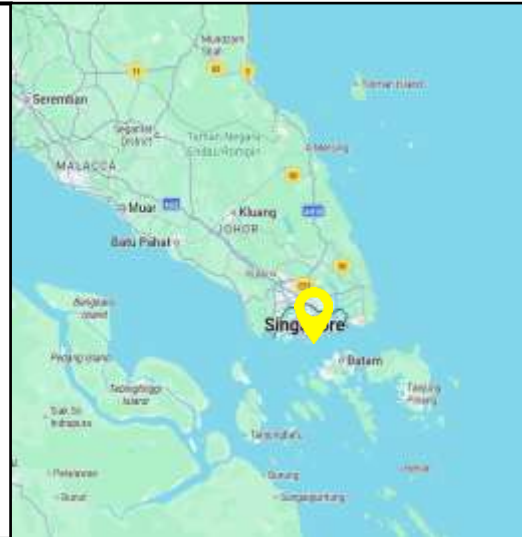

12 Jun/ Three Dead After Supply Boat Sinks/ Singapore

2026.06.12	Singapore	Pasir Panjang Terminal	Capsizing/ Sinking	Supply Boat	The deceased, believed to be crew members of the sunken supply boat, are aged between 38 and 53 and were confirmed dead by a paramedic from the Singapore Civil Defence Force.

Three individuals died when a supply boat sank following a collision with a landing craft off Singapore's Pasir Panjang Terminal on Friday 12 Jun 26 morning at approximately 0930 Hrs. The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) activated search and rescue efforts, deploying the Police Coast Guard (PCG) and the Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF) Marine Division immediately after the incident.

14 Jun/ Four Dead After High-Speed Craft Collides with Sailboat/ Croatia

2026.06.14	Croatia	Croatian Waters	Collisions	High-Speed Craft and Sailing Boat	All the passengers aboard the Krilo Eclipse were disembarked at Milna and then transferred to another ship that took them to Hvar.

A collision occurred on 14 Jun 26 in the Split Straits, Croatia, between the Croatia-flagged high-speed craft Krilo Eclipse and a French-flagged sailboat, resulting in four deaths and injuries to four others. The incident took place around 1130 Hrs local time in the Splitske Vrata passage. The sailboat, carrying eight Czech nationals, collided with the high-speed craft, which had 118 passengers and seven crew members. A search and rescue operation involved multiple agencies. While four from the sailboat were rescued, three were confirmed dead, and one went missing. On 15 Jun 26, police divers recovered the body of the fourth missing person, bringing the death toll to four.



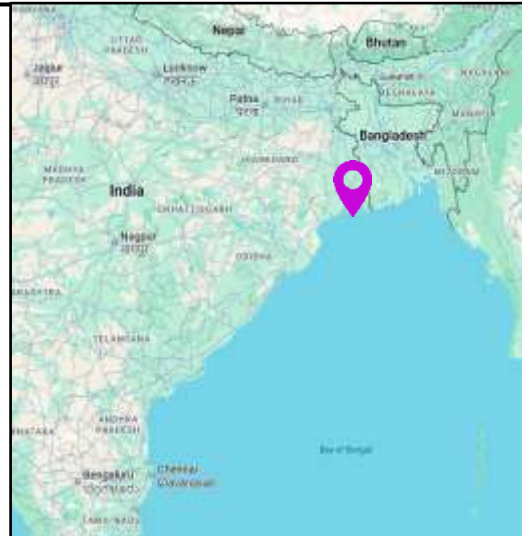

15 Jun/ Indian Navy Set To Commission Three Warships/ India

2026.06.15	India	Kolkata	Naval Activities	INS Dunagiri INS Agray INS Sanshodhak	This will be the second instance in recent years of three frontline naval platforms being commissioned together.

The Indian Navy will simultaneously commission three warships in Kolkata during the third week of June. This event, involving the stealth frigate INS Dunagiri, the anti-submarine warfare shallow water craft INS Agray, and the survey vessel INS Sanshodhak, is expected to be attended by a senior government official and may coincide with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the city.
