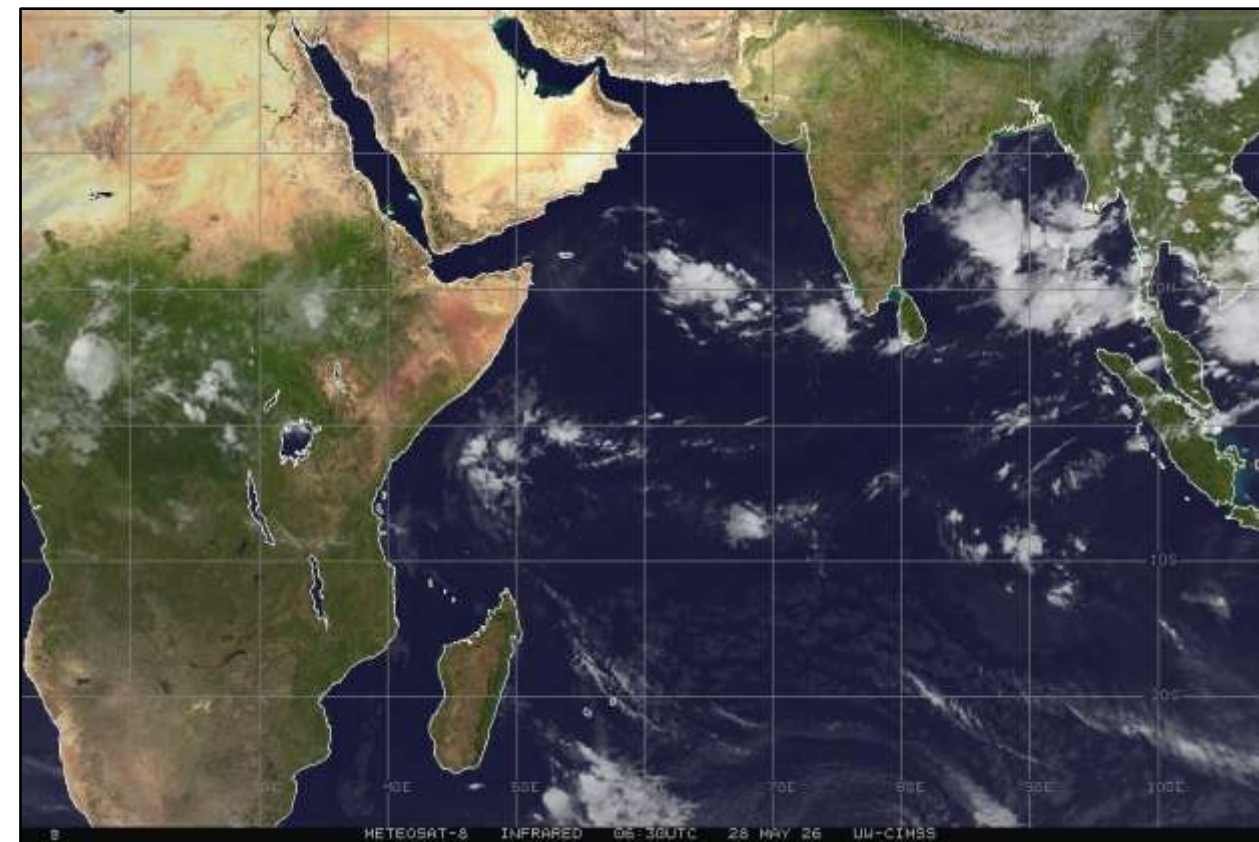

Slight to moderate elsewhere.

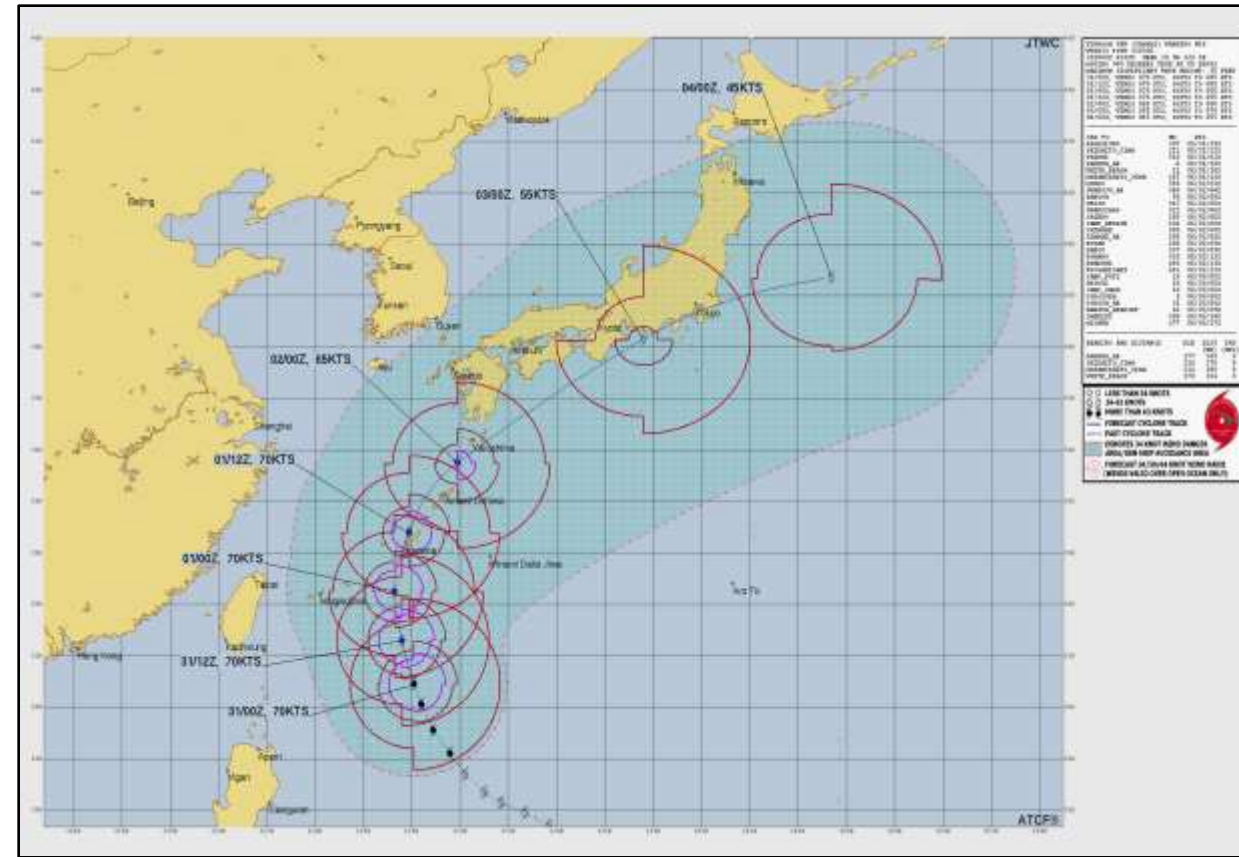
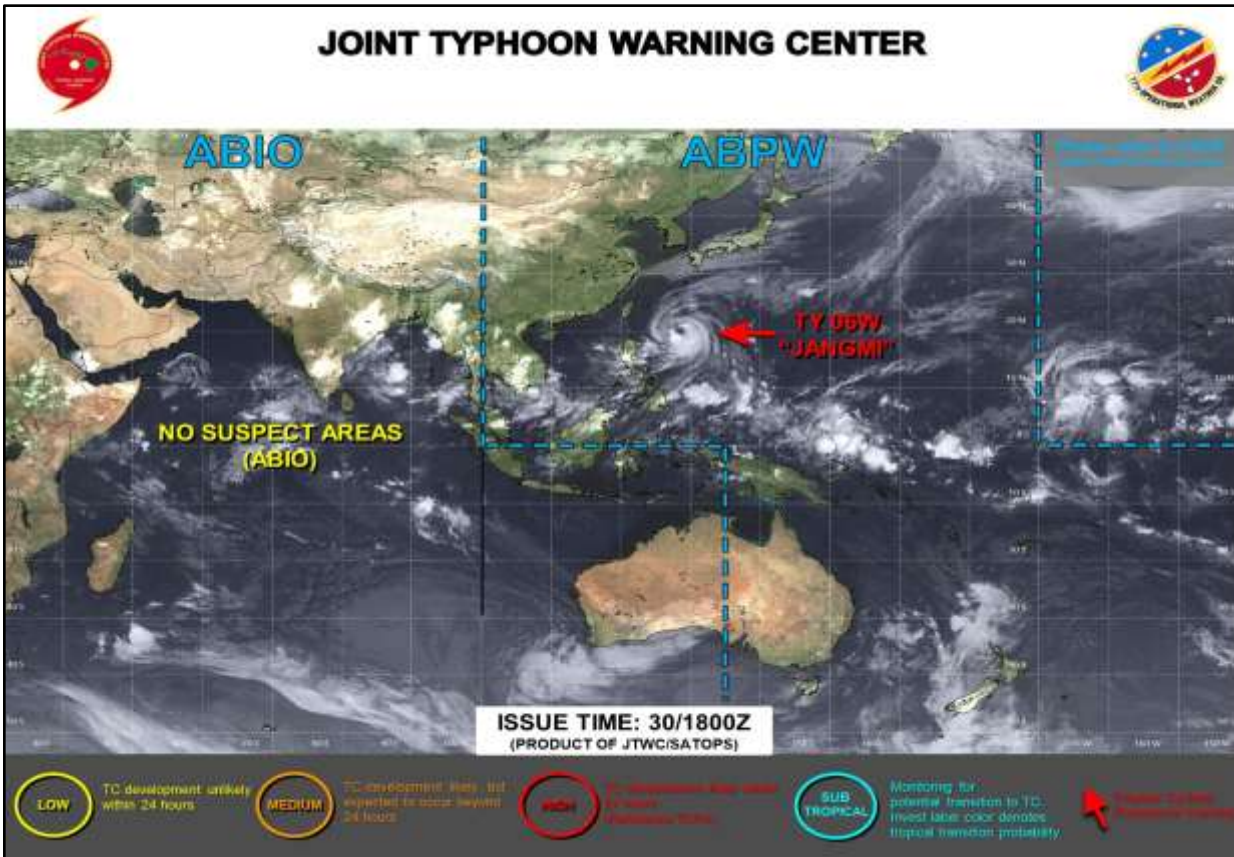

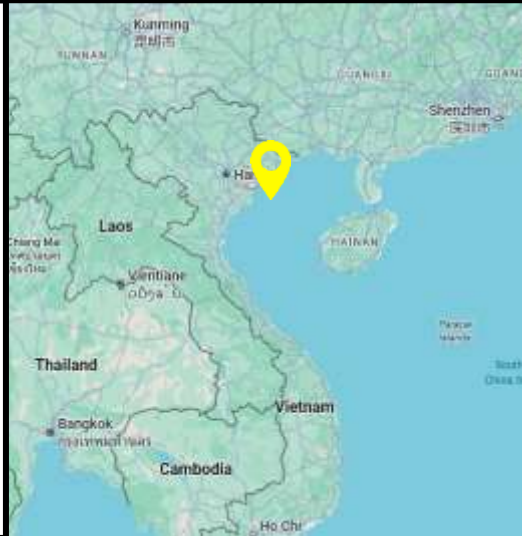

27 May/Fishing Boat Carrying 11 Sinks Off Hai Phong, Two Still Missing / Vietnam

2026.05.27	Vietnam	coast of Hai Phong	Capsizing /Sinking	Fishing Vessel	The Hai Phong Border Guard Command also deployed two rescue vessels while mobilizing nearby fishing boats to join the operation.

A fishing vessel HP 90666 TS sank near Hai Phong on 26 May 26 due to strong waves with two of its 11 crew members missing. The Vietnam Maritime Search and Rescue Coordination Center received a distress call at 1700hrs . approximately 15 nautical miles southeast of Long Chau Island. By 27 May nine crew members were rescued and search efforts for the remaining fishermen continued with support from local authorities the Coast Guard Navy forces and the National Civil Defence Steering Committee.

SMUGGLING



23 May/Navy Seizes P113-million Smuggled Cigarettes /Philippine

2026.05.23	Philippine	Basilan, Sulu	Contraband /Goods smuggling	-	Authorities said boarding teams confirmed the cargoes lacked permits and legal documentation.

The Philippine Navy's Western Mindanao Naval Command and Naval Task Force 61 intercepted two smuggling attempts in Basilan and Sulu seizing over P113 million in undocumented foreign cigarettes. On 23 May 26 they captured a vessel near Tongquil Island with 282 master cases valued at P42.7 million followed by another vessel near Sibago Island the next day with 473 master cases worth P70.9 million leading to crew arrests under the Anti-Agricultural Economic Sabotage Act.

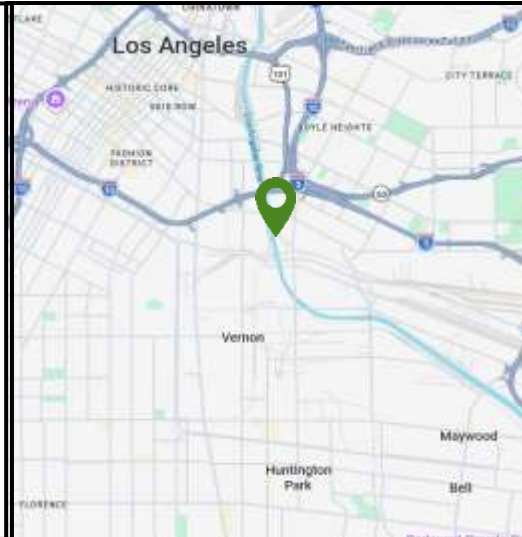

26 May/Cleanup Continues After 2,400 Gallons of Oil Spill / USA

2026.05.26	USA	LA River	Oil Spill	-	Efforts to contain the spill in the L.A. River have been underway over the past several days. So far, trained wildlife volunteers have treated more than two dozen oil-soaked birds found along the river.

A crude oil spill from a ruptured pipeline in East Los Angeles has spread down the LA River leading to a significant multi-agency cleanup and concerns among local residents. Over 2,000 gallons of crude oil leaked into storm drains connected to the river. Cleanup efforts were ongoing as of Monday with officials acknowledging the community's disruptions and seeking patience from residents during the process.
