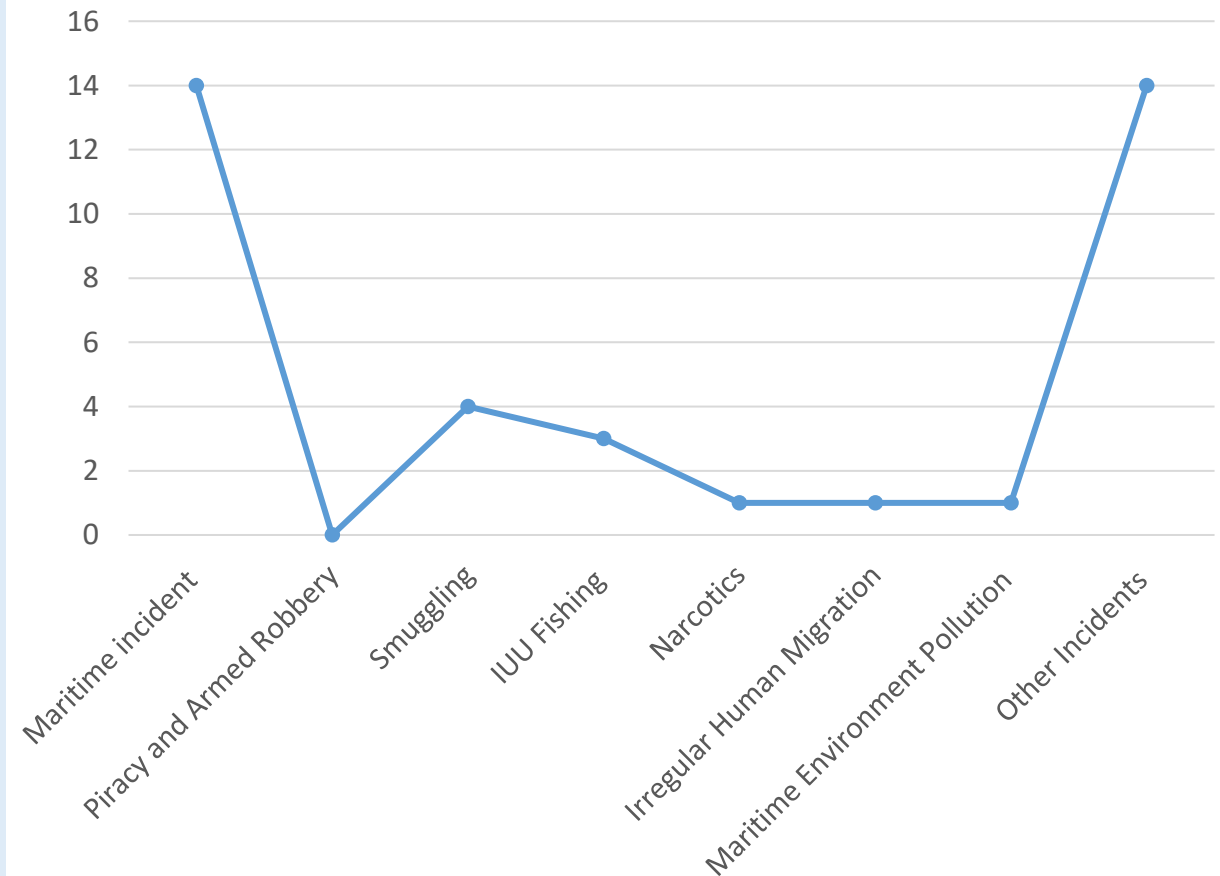
WEEKLY ANALYSIS

This week, 38 incidents were reported globally. Among these, 14 maritime safety incidents reported. No piracy or armed robbery incidents were reported. Smuggling accounted for 04 incidents. IUU fishing accounted for 03 incidents, all reported in Sri Lanka, involving illegal fishing equipment and the harvesting of protected marine species such as sea cucumbers and sharks. Narcotics-related incidents accounted for 01 incident. Irregular human migration accounted for 01 incident, involving an overcrowded migrant vessel in the English Channel. Maritime environmental pollution accounted for 01 incident. Further 14 other incidents were recorded, Weather-related incidents included 04 tropical cyclones and 10 earthquakes.

Recommendations

To strengthen maritime domain awareness through continuous AIS monitoring, satellite surveillance, coastal radar, and real-time intelligence sharing, with particular attention to the Strait of Hormuz, Gulf of Oman, Red Sea, Black Sea, and Indian Ocean. Enhance naval and coast guard surveillance to identify potential threats to commercial shipping and maintain safe navigation in conflict-affected waters. Strengthen maritime enforcement in Sri Lankan waters through coordinated Navy–Coast Guard–Fisheries surveillance to counter IUU fishing, sea-cucumber and shark exploitation, and smuggling activities. Improve SAR preparedness and rapid-response capabilities, particularly for fishing communities and small craft operating during adverse weather conditions. Strengthen oil-spill preparedness and environmental monitoring around major shipping routes. Finally, maintain close monitoring of geopolitical and military developments around the Strait of Hormuz, Gulf of Oman, Red Sea, and Black Sea, as escalation in these areas could significantly affect regional maritime security, commercial shipping, and global energy supply chains.
